TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Pro & Open Divisions

Pro Division - Any team that has fished more than two prize money tournaments.

Open Division - Any team that enjoys fishing.

The tournament will consist of two-man teams and each team must provide their own boat.

The Tournament will be laid out in two stages:

Stage One	Bass (Large or Small Mouth)
<i>Start Time:</i>	Friday 6:30 AM - 4:00 PM
Stage Two	Pan Fish (Sunfish, Crappie, Perch)
<i>Start Time:</i>	Saturday 6:30-11:00 AM

Fish will be weighed and teams will be ranked after each stage. The average rank of both stages will determine a team's final standing. Prizes for quantity and quality of fish will be awarded for each stage.



BIG PIKE CONTEST

Big Pike and Walleye can strike at any time and on any bait here on the chain of lakes. The fisherman who lands the biggest legal Pike during any stage of the tournament will be rewarded a new rod and reel and some fishing tackle!
