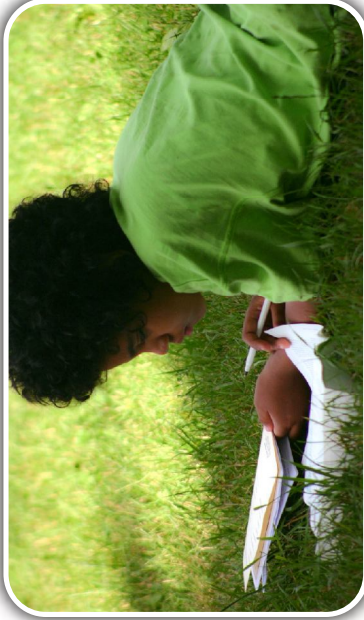
WHAT WE ARE TRYING TO ACCOMPLISH...
