DR. LEONARD SAUNDERS

Dr. Leonard Saunders was born in Dalles, OR and attended Highlands High School in North Highlands, California, graduating in 1967. He earned a B.A. from Maranatha Baptist Bible College, Watertown, WI in 1972 and a Doctorate of Divinity in 1995 from Maranatha Baptist Bible College.

Leonard married Norma J. Mowry in 1971. The Saunders' have 3 married children and seven grandchildren.

Dr. Saunders began his ministry service in 1972 as a Youth Pastor and Christian School Teacher at Bethany Baptist Church, Melbourne, FL. In 1974, he became the Assistant Pastor at Highlands Baptist Church, North Highlands, CA where he served until 1975 when he became the Youth Pastor at Temple Baptist Church in LaCrosse, WI. He began to bring the youth group to Camp Chetek at this time. From 1976-1980, Dr. Saunders served as Youth Pastor at First Baptist Church in Farmington, MI. In 1980, he was called to be Senior Pastor of Trinity Baptist Church, Flushing, MI.

In addition to preaching weekly services at Trinity, Dr. Saunders speaks at conferences, seminars, couples retreats and revival meetings. He serves in the soul winning and visitation ministries at Trinity.

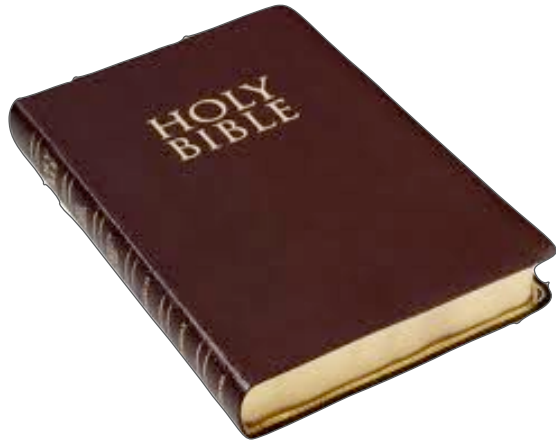
