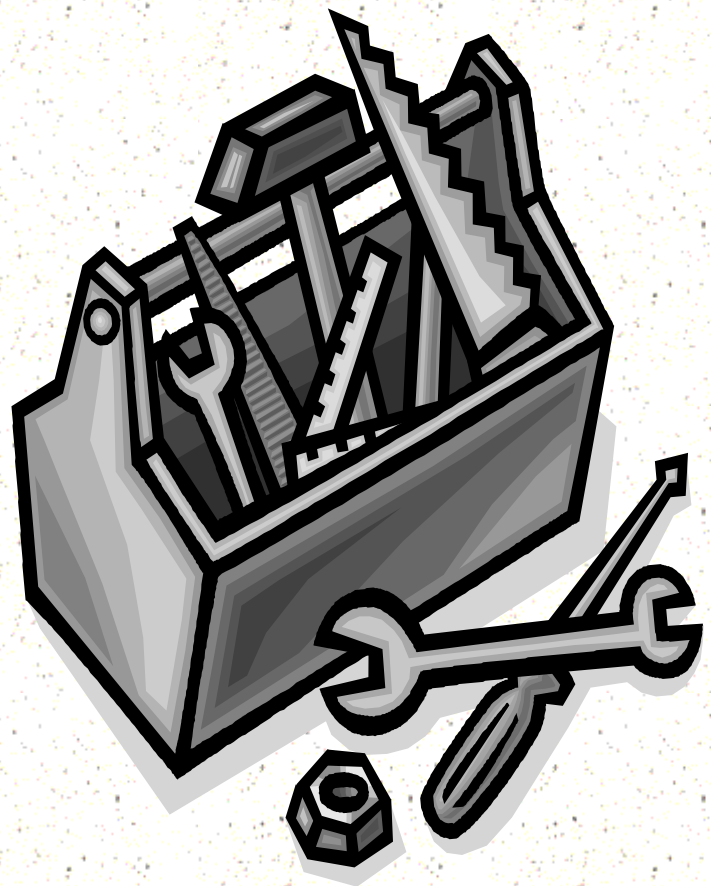

Pastor Bob Hassel

Pastor Bob Hassel attended Maranatha Baptist Bible College in Watertown, WI graduating in 1984 with a Bachelor of Science in English Bible and a Master of Science in English Bible two years later. He then served as an assistant pastor at Faith Baptist Church in Champaign, IL for four years. Pastor Hassel accepted the position of senior pastor in April of 1991 and has served faithfully in that capacity until the present time. He has been married to his wife, Lynn, for twenty-four years and has four children. The following is a revival report written by him. It is a wonderful example to us of how God truly answers prayer:

“Over a year ago, the Lord led us to schedule revival meetings with Brother Vaughan. The meetings were scheduled to be held September 10-13. During the four days of meetings, God met with His church in a supernatural way. Many Christians attended prayer meetings every night weeping and crying out for God's blessing upon His people. God's people were confessing sin and getting right with one another. There was a spirit of brokenness, love, and hunger for God in our church. We could sense the presence, power, and conviction of God in every service.

God has worked far beyond anything we could ever imagine. We truly serve a Great and Mighty God. God has allowed the meeting to change from four day meeting to a two week meeting. God brought over 25 people to our Monday prayer meeting and it took three church vans and a car to transport the Christians who came out for visitation. Families are unplugging their television sets are spending time in family prayer and Bible study. Christians are excited about hearing God's Word and there is a real concern and love for the unsaved.”
