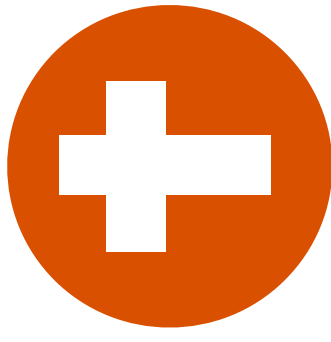

Be a Part of the *TEAM* at Camp Chetek

Purpose

Camp Chetek's **TEAM** program strives to:

1. Help teens grow in Christ through the teaching and practical application of God's Word.
2. Instill a Godly work ethic and Christ-like servant's spirit in today's youth.
3. Provide a Christian atmosphere for teens to fellowship with other believers and have an enjoyable camp experience.

Program

Character Development:

Biblical teaching on servant **leadership, attitude, devotion.** Application of all of these and more truths will help teens develop godly character.

Course:

You will be involved in a week of leadership training which will include teaching/preaching sessions and activity and serving times. Teaching/Preaching these sessions will be Dr. Matt Williams and Mr. Trevor Gearhart, both of Northland International University, as well as Evangelist Scott Sivnksty. When finished with the leadership training, you will have two weeks of serving in the kitchen, cleaning or maintenance areas of camp.

Choice:

Choose which option works best for your schedule. You must attend one week of "Training Camp" in order to work in the **TEAM** program. Two weeks of service are also required. Weeks of service are recommended in the option you choose, but you can work in either option once the "Training Camp" is completed.

Commitment:

Three week minimum

Character:

A testimony to live for God and a desire to develop godly character as you learn to serve the Lord.

Cost:

\$215 (\$40 registration deposit included). A \$40 registration deposit is required prior to arrival. The \$40 registration fee can be applied to a week of Teen Camp if you are not accepted in the **TEAM** program.

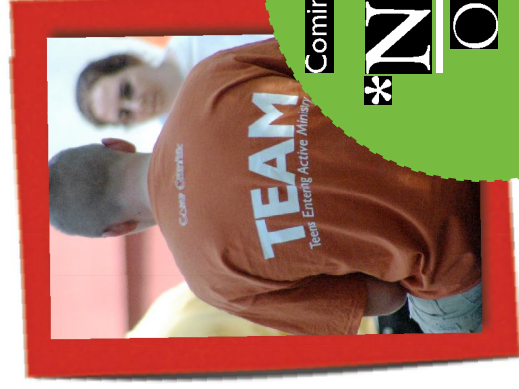
***\$20 discount** if paid in full by **April 1st (Please note-this is an earlier date than previous years).**

Personnel

The **TEAM** program is for teens who are truly serious in their walk with Christ and meet these qualifications:

1. Salvation and a desire to serve and willingness to grow in Christ.
2. A high school student (entering **10th-12th** grade, or graduate from high school this spring).
3. Attend one training week
4. Serve a minimum of two weeks
5. Have parental permission
6. Have pastoral recommendation
7. Willing to follow Camp Chetek **TEAM** policies and procedures
