Exodus 15: Praise and Pouting

Three days after the great miracle of the Red Sea crossing and the destruction of the Egyptian army, God's chosen people faced a test combining their urgent physical need, and their trust in God's wisdom and goodness.

- No water
- Bitter Water
- Sweet water

God's Solution -

God showed the leader what to do! (a tree)

- to sweeten the bitter

God spoke an affirmation of His love and authority, and led them to Elim.

The People's Response - a restful campout, but temporary trust and gratitude
